\ ä \ = as in **f**ather, **saw**, **a**we

\ A \ = as in **m**ade, **d**ate, **f**ade

\ e \ = as in **w**et, **m**et, **swe**at

\ E \ = as in **b**eat, **f**ee**t**, **e**lect

\ O \ = as in **o**h, **b**old, **n**o

\ ü \ = as in **b**oom, **l**oom, **r**oom

\ & \ = (in this context) as in "shake '**n**' bake"

\ r \ = is a tripped 'r'

All other consonants in this song are the same as you would pronounce them in English.
